## Waste Management Invites Tenders for Fencing and Oil Containment Structure

The Department of Waste Management is accepting quotations for the fencing and construction of an oil containment structure at the Old Derelict Vehicle Storage site, Sea Cows Bay, Tortola.

The fencing is to be constructed according to the following specifications:

- Fencing should be six feet in height.
- A gate with an opening space of sixteen feet wide.
- A double gate is to be supplied and installed in the space.
- An independent assessment of the site should be conducted by all bidders to gain an understanding of the scope of works.

- Quotation for work
- A Certificate of Good Standing from Inland Revenue Department, Social Security Board and National Health Insurance.
- Valid Trade License 2025
- Proof of ownership of equipment or access to it [pictures, insurance, registration etc]
- A brief outline of the company's experience

Interested tenderers are asked to attend a site visit at 11:00 a.m. on July 8, at the Waste Oil Storage Facility at Sea Cow's Bay to assess and confirm the requested scope of works. The deadline for submission of quotation is July 17, 2025 at 4:00 p.m.

The bid evaluation criteria are Methodology – 20 marks, Timeframe - 20 marks and Price – 60 marks.
