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Let's talk about **REPORTING MARINE ACCIDENTS**

In the British Virgin Islands, it is required by law to report marine accidents to the Marine Safety Investigation and Reporting Authority (MSIRA). The Authority has implemented simple measures to facilitate reporting. Here are some helpful tips, facts, and guidelines:

1 MSIRA is available online at Gov.vg

All information related to the **MSIRA is available online at Gov.vg**. You can locate the Accident Report Form and all associated information about the authority, including relevant legislation, by searching for "MSIRA" within the new government portal.

2 Send a report via email

3 Contact MSIRA directly
