Manchester Road Rehabilitation Project Completed Ahead of October Deadline

The Manchester Road rehabilitation project has been completed ahead of the

October completion date and is now serving motorists and pedestrians.

Road works commenced on the project after the August holidays for the

construction of approximately four hundred and twenty (420) linear feet of

concrete road pavement. The completed works are now alleviating the constant

view of running water on the main road while also protecting the road from

degradation.
