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Applications for the Student Vacation Visa Waiver Programme

The Department of Immigration is now accepting applications for the Student Vacation Visa Waiver Programme for the upcoming **Christmas vacation period, December 2025**.

Parents intending to take advantage of the Student Vacation Visa Waiver Programme should submit their application to the Department of Immigration **three weeks prior to the intended date of arrival, for approval**. Qualifying children under this programme should be **no older than 17 years old** and enrolled in **primary or secondary school** in their home country. **The requirements are as follows:**

- A written request from the residing parent for their child's entry;
- Proposed travel itinerary (with a departure date no later than December 31);
- Copy of parent(s) residing in the Territory passport bio page;
- Copy of parent(s) immigration entry permit;
- Accommodation verification in the form of a lease or letter from landlord indicating the space rented and details on all persons residing within the space (multi-family homes are to be noted);
- An official letter from the school the child currently attends, indicating closure and re-opening dates; and

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- An official letter from the school the child currently attends, indicating closure and re-opening dates; and
- Child's birth certificate (original or certified copy).
