Job Summary: A Member of the Financial Services Appeal Board (the “Board”) is responsible for participating in the activities of the Board as it relates to the handling of appeal matters in accordance with the Financial Services Appeal Board Act and the Board’s Rules of Procedure.

Minimum Educational Requirements: Bachelor’s Degree preferably in law and/or other financial services related field of study.

Training/Skill/Experience Requirements:

1. Minimum five (5) years working experience in field of expertise.
2. Leadership and problem-solving skills.
3. Ability to think strategically, manage complexity and act decisively.
4. Ability to maintain confidentiality.
5. Sound judgment, integrity, and a commitment to upholding the highest ethical standards.
6. Sound written and oral communication skills.
7. Strong interpersonal skills, and the ability to maintain good working relationships.
8. Proficient understanding of financial services legislation.

3. Receiving and considering written complaints relative to the affairs of the Board and dealing with the complaints in such manner as the Board considers appropriate.
