

Invitation for Bids for the Completion of the National Emergency Operation Centre Building now Opened

received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in an amount equivalent to USD \$65M towards the cost of the RRL Hurricane Irma Project and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds to eligible payments under this contract. Payment by CDB will be made only at the request of GOVI and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement. The Loan Agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the Loan Account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOVI shall derive any rights from the Loan Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Loan.

The Ministry of Finance is the Executing Agency for the Project, and is responsible for the overall implementation of the project. The Ministry of Finance intends to invite sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the supply of **Completion of Construction of National Emergency Operation Centre Building.**

The bidding process is conducted according to the procedures specified in the Procurement Procedures for Projects Financed by CDB (January, 2021), as published on CDB's website and is open to all bidders from eligible countries.

Firms whether applying individually or in the form of a Joint Venture, shall:

- (a) be legally incorporated or otherwise organised in, and have their principal place of business in an Eligible Country;
- (b) be more than fifty (50) percent beneficially-owned by a citizen or citizens

- (a) an average annual turnover (defined as certified payments received for works in progress or completed) within the last 3 years of at least four million United States dollars (USD 4M)); and
- (b) experience in successfully implementing at least three (3) similar type contracts of a nature, scope and complexity comparable to the proposed project activity within the last 5 years (to comply with this requirement, works quoted should be at least 80 percent complete).

They shall have no arrangement and undertake not to make any arrangement whereby the majority of the financial benefits of the contract, will accrue or be paid to sub-contractors or sub-consultants that are not from an eligible country.

Eligible bidders will be required to submit full qualification information with their bids establishing their eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted.
