Introduction to the Five Focus Areas

As we move from COI implementation to wider ongoing reform, we continue to focus on:

- **1. Completing COI Recommendations**
Finish agreed actions, bring legislation into force and complete other reforms.
- **2. Public Education**
Help the public understand the reforms, their impact and how to access information and services.
- **3. More Robust Laws, Policies and Institutions**
Strengthen the laws, policies and institutions that support and sustain reform.
- **4. Reviewing, Monitoring, and Evaluating**
Track progress and assess whether reforms are working as intended.

Governance Reform is the continuing work to strengthen how the Virgin Islands is governed through laws, policies, institutions, public education, monitoring, and lasting system changes.

As we move from Commission of Inquiry (COI) implementation to wider ongoing reform, the focus remains on five key areas:

- Completing COI Recommendations
- Public Education
- More Robust Laws, Policies, and Institutions
- Reviewing, Monitoring, and Evaluating
- Lasting System Changes
