Private candidates registered for the Alternative Paper 042 in the French and Spanish Unit 1 and Unit 2 examinations will not be required to take a written paper but will be required to take the oral examinations. No dates have been scheduled for the oral examinations; however, they must be taken between 13 April – 01 May at the discretion of the Local Registrar.
4. Art & Design: The Question Papers for Unit 1 Paper 2 and Unit 2 Paper 2 are to be handed to candidates on Thursday, 16 April. The examinations must be completed during the period 07 – 20 May.
5. Use of Dictionaries
