



**Remarks by Premier And Minister for Finance
Honourable Dr. Natalio D. Wheatley
At the Overseas Territories Attorneys General Conference**

Theme: Stronger Together: Common Challenges, Collaborative Solutions

Madam Chair, Honourable Attorneys General, distinguished delegates, invited guests, ladies and gentlemen,

Good morning.

On behalf of the Government and people of the Virgin Islands, it is my privilege to welcome you to our shores for this year's Overseas Territories Attorneys General Conference. We are honoured to host you, and we extend a particularly warm Virgin Islands welcome to those who have travelled to be with us in person. We hope that, even with the important work ahead, your visit will not be *all* business. When we align standards where appropriate, we make coordination across jurisdictions more seamless. And when we face common threats with a united front, we enhance the security and credibility of all our Territories.

I wish each of you a productive and engaging conference. The Virgin Islands looks forward to the insights that will emerge from your deliberations, and to the continued partnerships that will ensure we remain, in every sense, stronger together.
